



Classification of Position: University Service Volunteer Position for African American Network (AAN)

Position Title: Faculty Coordinator

Position Description:

The AAN Faculty Coordinator works closely with students, faculty, campus constituents as well as staff within the Office of Student Diversity, Engagement and Success (SDES) to help African American/Black students achieve their academic goals while also assisting students in the preservation of their cultural heritage. This includes planning and implementing academic, social, and cultural programming, meeting with students to connect them to campus resources, and representing SDES in cross-campus collaborations. This volunteer opportunity is housed within SDES.

An ideal candidate for this position should expect to volunteer for no more than 5 hours per month, for a 2-year term. They ideally identify as having an affinity with this racial group or conducts research based on the identity group.

Position Coordinator Duties:

- Conclude lecture series presentations (2-3 per academic year)
- Meet with student workers and SDES diversity coordinator once a month
- Provide input for the identity celebratory months

Identity Celebratory Months

- February: African American History Month
- May: Asian Pacific Heritage Month
- September: National Hispanic Heritage Month (Sept. 15th- Oct. 15th)
- November: American Indian Heritage Month
